ATV Course Closed

REMINDER: The USAG Fort Carson DFMWR sponsored All-Terrain Vehicle Course near Gate 20 is closed and has been turned over to the 4th Infantry Division to use as a military training area. Privately owned and operated ATVs are no longer authorized in this area.

Heating to Cooling

The Directorate of Public Works (DPW) operations and maintenance contractor begins the transition from heating to cooling season during the month of May, which includes turning off heating and preparing buildings for cooling. The process to turn off heating and prepare cooling systems for the summer takes about four weeks and is completed based on facility type. Often during this time of year, temperatures fluctuate greatly. Regardless of how well the DPW plans, weather on a particular day may make the indoor air less than comfortable during this transition period. The DPW staff appreciates customer patience as the seasonal transition takes place. The following is a tentative schedule for shutting down and isolating heating systems to prepare for the upcoming cooling season. For more information about the heating to cooling season transition, call the DPW Operations and Maintenance Division at 526-9241. Building occupants can call in service orders for maintenance and repair, including heating issues, to the contractor at 526-5345. Service orders can be called in seven days a week, 24 hours a day.

CIF Appointments

Soldiers do not have to wait for their clearing papers to schedule their organizational clothing and individual equipment (OCIE) turn in. Soldiers can schedule appointments for turn in 120 days out from PCS/ETS/retirement with a signed memorandum by the Soldier's company commander approving early turn in of OCIE equipment. Without the memorandum, Soldiers can schedule turn in 90 days out from PCS/ETS/retirement with a copy of their orders. To schedule, call the Fort Carson Central Issue Facility (CIF) at 719-526-3321 to speak to a customer service representative.

EACH migrates to MHS GENESIS

Evans Army Community Hospital (EACH) recently migrated to a new Electronic Health Record and Patient Portal under MHS GENESIS April 24. MHS GENESIS is a new, patientcentric enterprise system designed to provide a single, continuous record of care for all DOD beneficiaries. The new MHS GENESIS Patient Portal securely connects a patient with their health care team and empowers them to become the driver of their health care. Due to the recent transition to a new Electronic Health Record and Patient Portal under MHS GENESIS, providers and patients may experience a short-term increase in wait times, as health care teams adapt to new, standardized workflows. Over time, providers and patients will see increased efficiencies across all health care activities. MHS GENESIS will result in faster and better management of chronic, complex and time-sensitive health conditions; provide automated, real-time clinical decision support for health care teams; and increase patient engagement capabilities that allow patients to communicate directly with providers.

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
GET HELP BUYING FOOD FOR YOUR FAMILY

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is an on-going monthly food benefit that helps Colorado families to afford healthy food when budgets are tight. SNAP gives you options--you can choose where to shop and what to buy. These benefits are for you!

SNAP is For You

SNAP is available for all eligible families. You can receive SNAP benefits if you have limited income or high living expenses. If you are an immigrant, receiving SNAP for eligible children (such as US Citizen kids) does not impact public charge. You can apply online for SNAP benefits using the Colorado PEAK website colorado.gov/PEAK or on your smartphone using the MyCOBenefits app. You can download the app from the Apple or Android app store.
